

# IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

<b>OPV</b>	Polio (OPV and/or IPV)	4 doses	For <u>ages 4-6</u> : 3 doses meet the requirement if one dose was given on or after the 4th birthday. For <u>ages 7-17</u> : 3 doses meet the requirement if at least one dose was given on or after the 2nd birthday.
<b>DTP</b>	(Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis) or any combination of DPT, DTaP, HDPT or DT	5 doses	For <u>ages 4-6</u> : 4 doses meet the requirement if one dose was given on or after the 4th birthday.
	<u>Age 7 years and older (Pertussis is not required)</u>		
	Td, DT, or DTP, DTaP or any combination of these	4 doses	For <u>ages 7-17</u> : 3 doses meet the requirement if at least one dose was given on or after the 2nd birthday. A booster Td is recommended for 7th grade entry.
<b>MMR*</b>	Measles, Mumps, Rubella separately	2 doses given entry transfer. or together	Required for Kindergarten entry and 7/8 <sup>th</sup> grade
		1 dose given separately or together	Grades 1-6.

<b>HepB</b>	Hepatitis B	3 doses entry/transfer.	Required for Kindergarten entry and 7/8 <sup>th</sup> grade
<b>Varicella</b> (Chicken Pox)		1 dose or proof of the disease	Required for kindergarten entry or student transfer <u>from outside California.</u>
<b>TST: Tuberculosis Skin Test (Mantoux Method)</b>		1 dose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written proof of date received, date read, reading of in duration in millimeters and signature of the doctor is required.</li> <li>• <u>The TST (Mantoux) test must be read within 48-72 hours of the date given to be valid.</u></li> <li>• The TST must be given within eighteen months prior to entry or transfer into kindergarten or six months prior to entry into grades 1-8 from outside Santa Clara County</li> <li>• Students with a previous or current positive TST (10 millimeters or greater of in duration) Must submit results of a current x-ray done in the United States within the past six months.</li> </ul>

*\*MMR doses must be on or after the first birthday. One dose must be MMR. The other dose may be any measles containing vaccine.*

A **HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR SCHOOL ENTRY** form is required upon enrollment in first grade. The form (PM171A) must be completed by your doctor. **Children may have the health exam as early as six months before starting kindergarten ( i.e. February 1) and up to three months after starting first grade ( i.e. December 1).** If a child does not have a form on file by December 1<sup>st</sup> of his/her first grade year, the law requires that we exclude him/her from school ( Health and Safety Code 324.3).
