CUSD End Of The Year Attendance Policy

Students must be in attendance on the last day of school to guarantee their place in the district for the following school year. When the student returns, if space is available at his or her school, the student will be reinstated. If no space is available, the student will be assigned to another school in the district where space is available. If the student is ill, parents must notify the school of the absence and provide a doctor's note from a local doctor verifying they are too sick to come to school. If a note cannot be provided by June 15, the student will be withdrawn. Re-registration will be required. As in the first day of school policy, students who have unexcused absences will be dropped from the roster.

First Day of School: August 20

The 2009-2010 school year begins on August 20, 2009. **Students must be in school on August 20 to hold their place at Lincoln and in the school district.** School begins promptly at 8:55 a.m. for grades one through five and AM kindergarten students. School begins promptly at 10:45 a.m. for PM kindergarten students. **Class lists will be posted on the windows of the school office on August 19 after 4:00 p.m.** Class assignments are tentative until the school has an accurate enrollment count.
